## Dear Parent,

• I hope you are all having a relaxing summer. Please read the following notes carefully in preparation for the start of a new school year in September.

- In order to facilitate families travelling to the All Ireland Final on Sunday, 2nd September, our school will be closed on Monday, 3rd September.
   Congratulations to the Tyrone players and management. We wish them every success in the final. Pupils are asked to return to school on Tuesday, 4th
   September at the usual time. Please note that this closure does not affect the Year One start dates previously distributed to parents.

• Please note that our school day starts at **9.10am**. Pupils are asked to arrive from **9.00am**. Pupils should not be in school earlier than this unless a special arrangement has been made with me. Please complete the slip attached if you wish your child/children to be supervised in school from 8.45am and return it to school by **Monday, 4th September**. Please note that pupils should not be in school prior

to 8.45am, as supervision cannot be guaranteed before this time. Any parents who have previously made an arrangement with myself regarding their child arriving in school earlier than 9.00am should complete the slip also. The front door will be closed each day at 9.10am, in the interests of child protection and safeguarding. If you need to enter the school after this time, please press the buzzer beside our postbox at the front door and someone will let you in. Our back door is for exiting only and will remain locked from the outside.

- To aid speedy administration in the morning, please send in all monies in the money wallets sent home in September. Additional wallets are available from the Parents' Noticeboard at the entrance to our school. Wallets must be marked with your child's name, class, date, what the payment is for, how much money is included for each item and the total amount of money enclosed. Pupils are asked to send the wallets into their class teacher each day in their Notes folder. Alternatively all monies for the week can be sent into the class teacher in one money wallet each Monday morning.
- Some items of clothing were left behind by pupils in the school in June. Any labelled items will be returned to your child in September. Unfortunately some of the items were not labelled and we are therefore unable to identify the owners. All items not labelled will be available from the Year Seven classroom on Wednesday 29th August from 7.30pm to 9pm if any parent would like to come in, identify and collect their child's belongings.
- Mrs. Taggart will be delivering an Information Evening for all Year 1 parents on Wednesday, 29th August @ 7pm in the school Assembly Hall. During the evening Mrs. Taggart will outline the routines, teaching and learning practices, etc., in the Foundation Stage. All Year 1 parents are invited to attend. Parents will be reminded at the meeting of their child's start date. During September we operate a staggered intake with a shorter day for pupils in Year 1. This means that the children can gradually adjust to a full day at school. Information will be given to parents regarding these times at the Information Evening. We look forward to seeing you then.
- Mrs. Taggart will issue a letter regarding provision for Music when school recommences.
- Teachers have requested that pupils do not bring pencil cases into school. All necessary stationery will be provided by the school. Pupils are asked to keep any stationery purchased for the start of the new year at home for completing homework tasks. Mrs. McConnell has asked that each pupil bring a **pencil** with them each day to school.
- To avoid distraction during teaching and learning time, pupils are asked to refrain from bringing in water or juice bottles into school. Pupils who take lunch may continue to bring water in as part of their lunch. Fresh water will be available in each classroom throughout the day. Pupils will be permitted to bring water with them when attending sports events outside.
