- As you may be aware Friends of St. Patrick's Eskra have funded the implementation of the Accelerated Reader Programme for one year in Years 5, 6 & 7. Accelerated Reading is a computer-based programme used to enhance reading comprehension. In preparation for the introduction of Accelerated Reader pupils in Years 5-7 have to complete an on-line test to determind a base-line reading score. The test will take 30 minutes per pupil. We have arranged to take the pupils to St. Ciaran's College, Ballygawley to complete the test simultaneously. Pupils will be travelling to St. Ciaran's on Thursday morning by bus and will be accompanied by two members of staff. Please complete the permission slip attached and return it to school by Wednesday of this week.
