Pupils with learning difficulties will receive their differentiated learning materials either by e-mail or in the form of a pack. This will be finalised in the coming weeks and parents will be kept informed. Teachers will also be giving guidance on weekly timetables to assist with timetabling at home. This will be for reference only.

**Accelerared Reader** is available at home now to all pupils in **Years 5-7.** Information on how to access this is included in your child's pack. If you experience any difficulties regarding access to Accelerated Reader, please contact the school office by e-mail or telephone during school hours, for assistance.

If you don't have access to the Internet or to a printer, please contact the school so that alternative arrangements can be made for your child.
