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FOREST SCHOOL



We walk to our Forest School.





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RULES



We listen to our rules – 1 whistle = stop, 2 whistles = back to base and 3rd rule = have fun and learn. We also remember to respect nature



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STAYING SAFE



We put out our boundary flags for us to stay inside





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WHITTLING



Today we are whittling to make bug houses – we use elder rods, hacksaws, potato peelers, tent pegs and wool



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WHITTLING



We use hacksaws to make our lengths of elder shorter



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WHITTLING



We use potato peelers to take the bark off the elder. This attracts the insects



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WHITTLING



Then we use our tent peg to push the centre (pith) of the bark out. The pupils had great fun helping each other pull the pegs out of the elder



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WHITTLING



We tie them together to make a bug house and leave them in trees/under hedges. The class were coming out again after lunch to make some more
